

Myrna Loy Grants to Artists 2024 Guidelines

Please read these guidelines before submitting your application. If your application doesn't comply with these guidelines, it may be rejected.

- 1. Eligible artists: Any individual artist in any genre, of any age, may apply as long as they live in the Myrna Loy's 3-county region: Jefferson, Broadwater, or Lewis & Clark County. It's hard to make a living as an artist in Montana. If you're new, or here temporarily, your application won't be as strong (just so you know). We have given grants to artists ages 16-70.
- 2. **Individuals only?** Yes. If you're in a band or collaboration you may apply as an individual for a single project—but this program doesn't fund groups or ensembles. (You can email for clarification.)
- 3. Eligible projects: We're looking for projects that will result in a product or body of work —an exhibit, a CD, a collection, a single work, etc. Project must be completed by June 30, 2025. You will be asked to share your work in some public fashion (exhibit, reading, podcast, online) so there must be something to show. In other words, we will not simply support you to spend time doing your work.
- 4. **Project description:** Do you want the review panel to get excited about your project? Here's your opportunity. Put some time and thought into this. If you say "see attached" we won't.
- 5. How funds will be applied: Be honest. We've given grants to rent scaffolding for an installation, or to pay postage for submissions. Don't try to make it sound sexy, just tell us what you need and why.
- 6. Spotlight grant: We have limited funds but a lot of connections and resources. Are there non-monetary ways we can help? Think about what you really need. Tech help? Expertise? Publicity campaign? (We just might give you money as well!)
- 7. **Budget:** Please submit all the information asked for. How you understand your project budget tells us a lot about your project. (We've kept it pretty simple to make it easy on you!)
- 8. Questions: Please EMAIL questions to: <u>myrnagrants@gmail.com</u> so that we can get you the best and most up to date information. If you call us, there is a chance our employees may not know the answer or give you incorrect information.
- 9. See all those other questions? Please answer them. If you don't have time, we probably won't either.
